ABSTRAK

Tanggung jawab negara terhadap warga negaranya menurut Hukum Internasional adalah bahwa setiap negara akan membela dan melindungi warga negaranya, baik di dalam wilayah negaranya maupun diluar wilayah kedaulatannya. Tulisan ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui peran dari Perwakilan Republik Indonesia dalam mengatasi permasalahan hak pendidikan anak-anak Pekerja Migran Indonesia di Malaysia Timur, tepatnya di Sabah dan Serawak, serta untuk mengetahui hambatan-hambatan yang dihadapi oleh Perwakilan Republik Indonesia dalam memfasilitasi akses pendidikan dan melindungi anak Pekerja Migran Indonesia. Peranan Perwakilan Republik Indonesia di luar negeri dalam memberikan perlindungan bagi warga negaranya termasuk dalam pelaksanaan tugas dan fungsinya di negara maupun organisasi yang diwakilinya. Perwakilan Republik Indonesia sebagai wakil dari negaranya merupakan “rumah” bagi seluruh Warga Negara Indonesia di luar negeri yang bertanggung jawab dalam perlindungan warga negaranya.

ABSTRACT

The responsibility of the state for its citizens according to International Law is that each country will defend and protect its citizens, both within the territory of their country and outside their territorial sovereignty. This paper aims to determine the role of the Representatives of the Republic of Indonesia in overcoming the problems of the education rights of Indonesian Migrant Workers' children in East Malaysia, precisely in Sabah and Sarawak, and to find out the obstacles faced by the Republic of Indonesia Representatives in facilitating access to education and protecting children Indonesian Migrant Workers. The role of the Representative of the Republic of Indonesia abroad in providing protection for its citizens is included in the implementation of its duties and functions in the country and organization it represents. Representatives of the Republic of Indonesia as representatives of their countries are "home" for all Indonesian citizens abroad who are responsible for the protection of their citizens.
