

DEVELOPMENT OF ACCOUNTING SERVICE CENTER (ASC) IN EXPANDING THE IMPACT OF HIGHER EDUCATION KNOWLEDGE ON SOCIETY

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Abstract

The educational directive outlined in Permendikbud No.3 of 2020 mandates universities and academic institutions to advance, cultivate, and share knowledge within the wider community. A prevalent requirement for accounting services exists, particularly as they often come at a prohibitive cost for micro, small, and medium enterprises (MSMEs). Furthermore, certain remote areas in Indonesia face a scarcity of accounting service providers. Hence, in August 2022, the Ministry of Education-backed Accounting Department at the University of Surabaya took the initiative to establish an Accounting Service Center (ASC) aimed at providing accessible accounting services to the community. Leveraging web-based software, this service enables remote community access. Consequently, the ASC's presence has fostered heightened community engagement among universities, faculty, and students,

facilitating the dissemination of knowledge for societal benefit. Notably, MSMEs can now access cost-effective, and in some cases, free accounting services, aiding in their financial management. The envisioned trajectory for the ASC involves broadening its scope of operations, augmenting the involvement of lecturers and students, ultimately culminating in an improved accounting literacy across the community.

Abstrak

Arahan pendidikan yang ditetapkan dalam Permendikbud No.3 tahun 2020 menganjurkan universitas dan institusi akademik untuk meningkatkan, mengembangkan, dan membagikan pengetahuan kepada masyarakat luas. Kebutuhan akan jasa akuntansi sudah umum, terutama karena sering kali jasa akuntansi dianggap mahal bagi usaha mikro, kecil, dan menengah (UMKM). Selain itu, beberapa daerah terpencil di Indonesia menghadapi kelangkaan penyedia jasa akuntansi. Oleh karena itu, pada bulan Agustus 2022, Jurusan Akuntansi yang didukung oleh Kementerian Pendidikan di Universitas Surabaya berinisiatif mendirikan *Accounting Service Center* (ASC) dengan tujuan untuk menyediakan layanan akuntansi yang dapat diakses oleh masyarakat. Memanfaatkan perangkat lunak berbasis web, layanan ini memungkinkan akses masyarakat secara jarak jauh. Kehadiran ASC telah mendorong keterlibatan masyarakat yang lebih luas di antara universitas, fakultas, dan mahasiswa, memfasilitasi penyebarluasan pengetahuan untuk kepentingan masyarakat. Khususnya, UMKM sekarang dapat mengakses layanan akuntansi yang hemat biaya, dan

dalam beberapa kasus, layanan akuntansi gratis, yang membantu manajemen keuangan mereka. Lintasan yang dibayangkan untuk ASC melibatkan perluasan cakupan pelaksanaannya, meningkatkan keterlibatan dosen dan mahasiswa, hingga akhirnya berujung pada peningkatan literasi akuntansi di seluruh masyarakat.
